## COMMITMENT TO ACCOMPLISHMENT

The Board accepts its ultimate responsibility for all facets of school operation and programs. Chief among its responsibilities is accomplishment of the goals and objectives it sets forth, subject to the financial support that must be given these aims by district residents.

As part of its accountability to district residents, the Board will maintain a program of accountability throughout the school system. This program will consist of the following elements:

- 1. Clear statements of expectations and purposes, as these relate to rates of operations, programs, departments, and positions.
- 2. Provisions of the staff, resources, and support necessary to achieve stated expectations and purposes.
- 3. Evaluation of operations, programs, instruction, and services to determine how well expectations and purposes are being met.
- 4. Evaluation of the efforts of individuals employed by the Board, and of the Board itself, with the first purpose of evaluation being to help all individuals make a maximum contribution to the goals of the school system.
- 5. Revision, modification, and innovation as necessary to accomplish purposes and improve operations and programs.

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
